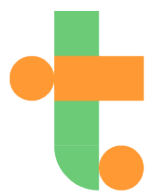

**A**t TechLeap India, we're driven by a bold and urgent mission: to ensure every child in India has access to quality education—regardless of their background, zip code, or family income. Our work begins with a belief that systemic change doesn't require reinventing the wheel; it requires resourcing the people who are already building it.

Rather than launching our own programs, we identify, vet, and fund high-impact nonprofits working on the ground across India—organizations that understand the unique challenges of their communities and have developed scalable, data-backed solutions. Your support allows us to empower these local changemakers through targeted grants that directly improve educational access, equity, and outcomes for underserved students.

We are proud to announce that our first grant will support the Neo Rajkot Foundation, a trusted NGO working with public schools in Gujarat. Their Center of Excellence program equips government classrooms with digital learning tools, internet connectivity, and access to MindSpark, an internationally recognized adaptive learning platform that helps students close foundational gaps in subjects like English and Math. This program, reaching over 7,000 students per week, has already shown measurable success—boosting student performance and increasing school enrollment rates—and our grant will help them expand into additional communities.

But this is just the beginning.

Over the next two years, TechLeap India aims to fund education transformation for 20,000 students across India. Through partnerships with NGOs, school systems, and community-based organizations, we're building a national network of localized impact—one that's transparent, accountable, and designed for long-term success.

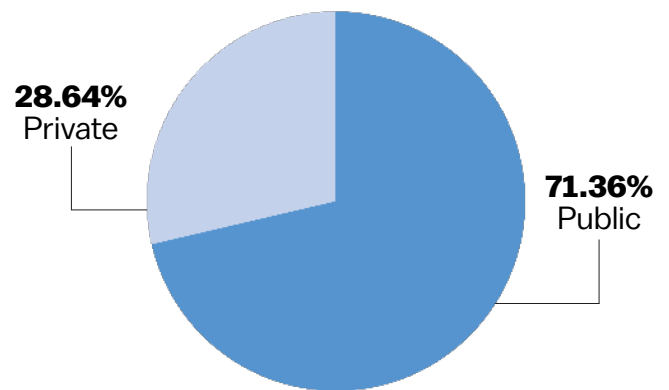

# EDUCATIONAL CHALLENGES: A BARRIER TO OPPORTUNITY

- **Grade-Level Mismatch:** In many schools, students are placed into grades based solely on their age, without consideration for their foundational knowledge or comprehension of the curriculum.<sup>1</sup> This one-size-fits-all approach poses significant challenges for students who enter school in later years or lack a solid academic base. Without the necessary grounding in core subjects, these students often find themselves struggling to understand complex material, leading to frustration, disengagement, and, ultimately, higher dropout rates.
- **Low Proficiency in Core Subjects:** According to a Stanford University survey, over 40% of students, across 10,000 schools in India, failed to meet grade-level proficiency in math and reading.<sup>2</sup> Without these basic skills, students struggle to progress in their studies and prepare for future careers.
- **High Dropout Rates:** Approximately 20% of students drop out before completing secondary school.<sup>3</sup> Lack of engagement, inadequate individualized support, and limited resources drive many students away from the educational system, cutting short their potential.

- **Lack of Basic Infrastructure:** A survey of government schools revealed that over 71% lack functional computer labs<sup>4</sup>, and 40% of public schools lack internet access<sup>5</sup>. - **Inadequate Classroom Supplies:** Nearly 50% of teachers report a shortage of essential classroom supplies such as notebooks, pencils, and textbooks.<sup>6</sup> Without these basics, students face additional challenges in staying engaged and completing assignments.

All partners are required to meet strict standards, including official registration as a nonprofit or not-for-profit in India. Furthermore, each partner is contractually obligated to use funds according to specific program needs, such as technology, teacher training, or student resources, guaranteeing that donations are spent with maximum impact in mind. To maintain transparency and accountability, NGOs are required to provide an itemized breakdown of how funds will be allocated and submit receipts to verify proper spending.

## 2. Sustainable Implementation

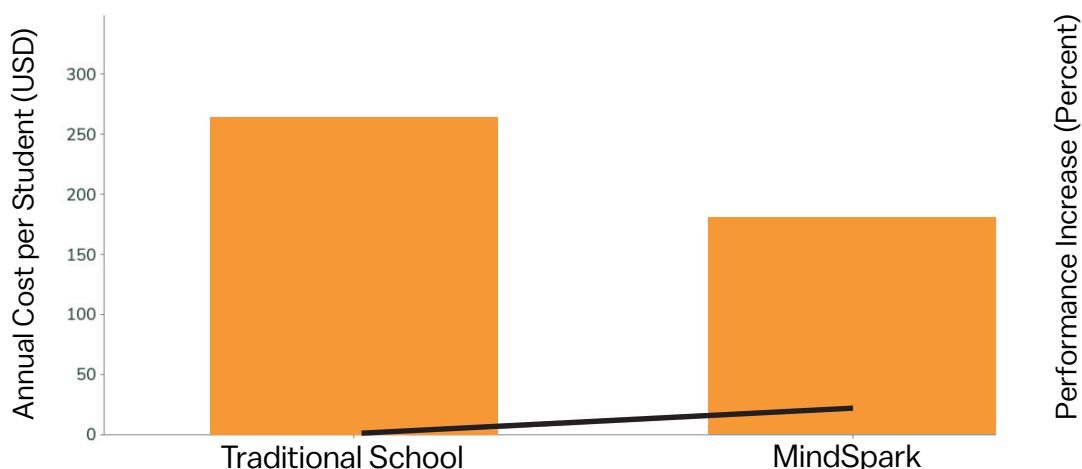

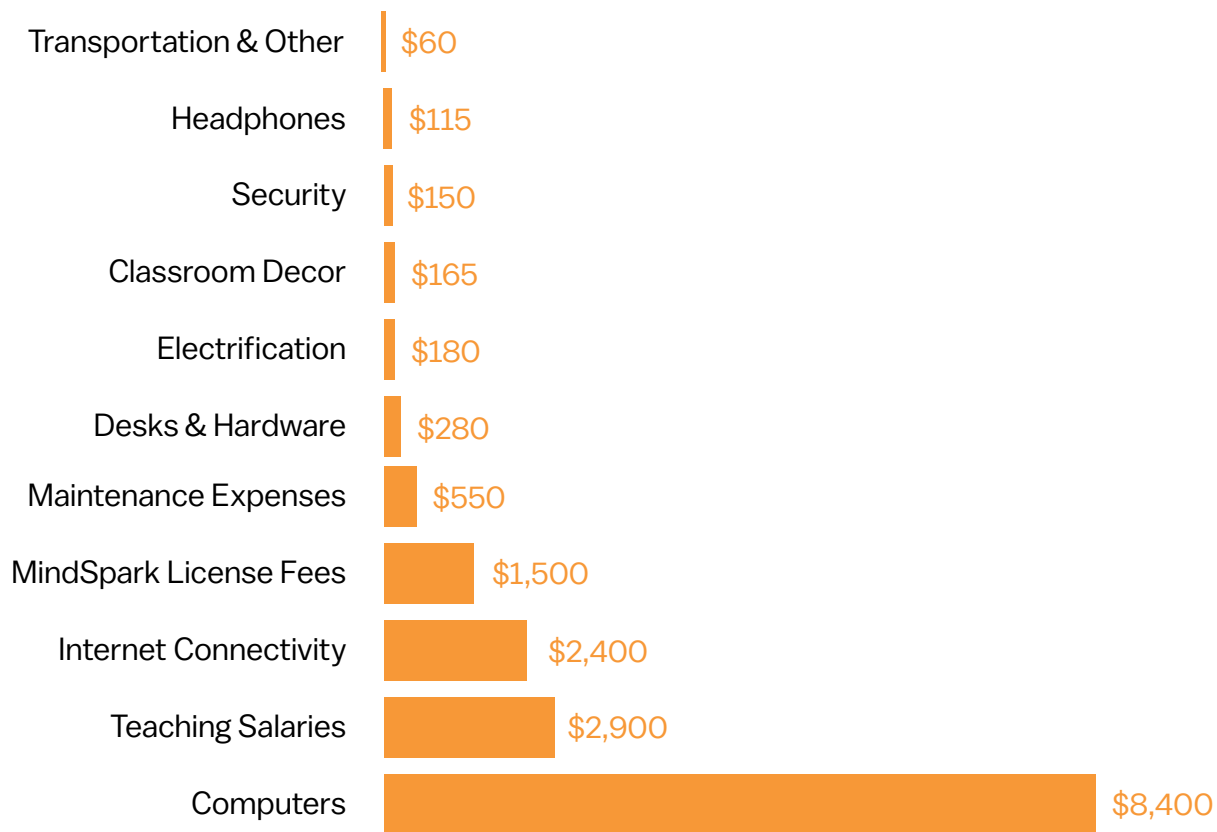
